Competitive Athlete Checklist

- Interclub Athletes: the apparatus you will compete with
- Provincial and National Athletes: mandatory 1 of each apparatus (ball, hoop, clubs, ribbon & rope)
- Rope
- Toe shoes: 1 pair for training and 1 pair reserved for competitions
- YS Tank Top
- YS Zip-Up Sweater
- Knee Pads
- Elastic stretching and conditioning band
- Ankle Weights
- Undersuit
- Suit
- Notebook and Pen (for coaches and athletes to keep track of comments and corrections)
- Water Bottle

Optional Accessories Checklist

- Ball pump
- Ball carrier
- Hoop cover
- Ribbon roller

Ball Guidelines

Preferred Brand: Chacott

Do not buy Pastorelli

Important Information To Note

Price Range: \$94-\$199

Color: Anything besides black or white (pearl is acceptable)

Size: Senior size for all competitive athletes; 18.5cm in diameter & 400g minimum.

Ball Care & Other Costs

Ball Care:

★ Deflate the ball during flight (because the air levels can change drastically)

- ★ Don't leave a ball in the cold for excessive periods of time (i.e. car trunk during winter)
- ★ Wrap ball to avoid scratches (can use ball bag or a toque/knit hat)
- ★ Only use appropriate ball pumps
- ★ Don't over-inflate the balls (they should stay slightly squeezable)
- ★ Best to ask a coach how to pump a ball

Ball Pump Price: \$10-\$35

★ The ball pump is an optional cost



Hoop Guidelines

Preferred Brand: No preferred brand but must be thin

★ Thin hoops are preferred because they are lighter and easier to work with (ask supplier if it's thin)

★ SIZING - CHECK WITH COACH AT THE GYM

Important Information To Note

Price range: \$35-\$65

Color: The hoop tape will be matched to the suit

Size: The hoop must reach the hip bone when standing beside the hoop.

81, 85 & 89cm hoops are standard sizes. CHECK WITH COACH AT THE GYM

Hoop Care & Other Costs

Hoop Care:

★ Avoid scratching hoop tape

★ If the hoop tape starts to peel, use ultra clear tape to stick it back down

★ Don't bend the hoop excessively

Hoop Taping Cost: \$20-\$40 (varies according to size and amount of tape/time) paid to coach

★ Hoop spray painting is also an option. Check with coaches first.

Hoop Cover Cost: \$40-\$85

★ The hoop cover is an optional cost but preferred if you are traveling with a hoop as it helps protect the hoop



Rope Guidelines

Preferred Brand: No preferred brand (can be Sasaki, Chacott, Pastorelli)

Do not buy rainbow rope on Amazon

Important Information To Note

Price Range: \$40

Color: Any color besides black or white

Size: Coaches at the gym MUST cut the rope to size

Material: Nylon

Rope Marker: We advise that each rope be marked by rungs of tape of varying color around the handles of the rope to help differentiate everyone's rope from one another (There are often a lot of pink ropes in the gym and when they get misplaced they're

hard to identify)



Club Guidelines

Preferred Brand: Sasaki - fully rubber & stackable

Do not buy Venturelli

Important Information To Note

Price Range: \$158-\$263

Color: Any color as they will be taped (unless otherwise specified)

Material: Fully rubber and stackable (can insert into one another)

Size: Senior size (if a gymnast is younger than 10 she should buy Junior clubs but will

have to switch to senior clubs in the later years)

Other Costs

Clubs Taping/Spray Painting Costs: \$15-\$25



Ribbon Stick Guidelines

Preferred Stick Brand: Venturelli

Second Suggested Stick Brand: Chacott

Do not buy Sasaki

Important Information To Note

Stick Price Range: \$68-\$115

Size: Senior stick

Ribbon Guidelines

Preferred Ribbon Brand: Chacott

Second Suggested Ribbon Brand: Sasaki

Do not buy Venturelli

Important Information To Note

Ribbon Price Range: \$30-\$70

Color: Match to suit (consult with coaches)

Size:

- ★ Senior ribbon 6 meters
- ★ Younger gymnasts can use 5 meter long ribbon but will have to get a longer one when they are older

Ribbon Care & Other Costs

Ribbon Care:

- ★ Loosely roll the ribbon when storing it
- ★ Don't fold them around the stick (it pokes holes in the ribbon)
- ★ Iron and lightly starch (you can use hairspray) the ribbon before competitions
- ★ They may be machine washable (gentle cycle)

Ribbon Roller: Sasaki or other

★ The ribbon roller is an optional purchase



Accessories

Toe Shoes

- ★ Sasaki sock toe shoes are the best quality and will last longest
- ★ Pastorelli sock toe shoes are not as good quality but are less expensive
- ★ Suede toe shoes are optional upon consultation with a coach as they only suit some gymnasts

York Stars Apparatus Store - Toe shoes are available for purchase at our gym

Toe shoe Care:

- ★ Machine wash toe shoes weekly on gentle cycle or hand wash
- ★ Lay flat to dry
- ★ Optional to sew or patch toe shoes if there is a hole

Knee Pads

- ★ Any volleyball knee pads are acceptable (can be found on Amazon or at Canadian Tire, etc)
- ★ Sasaki knee pads have more padding and are recommended if purchasing RG specific pads
- ★ Do not buy Pastorelli knee pads because they are too thin

Elastic Bands

- **★** Buy stretching elastic here
- ★ We recommend getting exactly this resistance band so that all our gymnasts have a uniform length and resistance level. Other ones are too strong or do not fit the girls feet/ankles properly (fall off)

Ankle Weights

- ★ 1-2 lb weights are recommended, which you can buy from many places. (Amazon, Canadian Tire...)
- ★ Do not buy red Goodlife weights because they break very easily

Undersuit

- ★ Skin coloured undersuits are required for all competitive athletes
- ★ This can be purchased at Second Skin Fashions Ltd. in Thornhill
 - You can mention York Stars and get a 10% discount
 - Please consider stock may be affected by the longer shipping periods.
- ★ This can also be purchased at On The Dance Floor in Richmond Hill and Gabies Boutique in Newmarket
 - We do not have a discount with them
- ★ The undersuit should be a full leotard or two pieces (skin tone bra and underwear from a dance store)



Suit

- ★ There will be a suit sale at the gym
 - o Rent or purchase options are available
- ★ Rent goes from \$75-\$350 depending on the suit's size & quality
- ★ Purchase can go from \$150-800
